## Development Galas – Supplementary Information

The Development galas are a series of Club organised events that are held over 3 dates throughout the season. They are run in a friendly way under ASA rules for the benefit of younger swimmers from Corby Swimming club and also invited swimmers from swimming schools to gain experience in entering galas. This will allow swimmers to get times for each discipline which can be used to grade progress and allow swimmers from swim schools to decide whether to progress to a competitive swimming club in the future.

### 1.0 Schedule of Events

The Development galas are held over 3 dates throughout the season on the dates specified on the club website. The events will be run at Corby East Midlands International Pool unless otherwise specified on a 8 x 25m pool Set Up. The swimmers will compete in their age groups on a HDW basis.

\*\* The age groups of 11 years are able to choose either 25m or 50m distances for Butterfly, but not both in the same stroke. Any swimmer in squads JC or JP may compete at 50m Butterfly regardless of age.

- 9/Under (for ages 5-9)
- 10 Years
- 11 Years
- 12 Years
- 13/Over

## 5.0 Qualifying Standards

No Upper or Lower Qualifying times have been set for this competition; all entries will be accepted if they meet the promoter's criteria. Entry times if submitted must be in 25m format.

## 6.0 Setting of Standards

All entrants must be a member of Corby Amateur Swimming Club.

Other competitors from local swim schools may be invited by the promoter to compete for new times and gain experience at galas. This will enable them to decide their future in maybe joining a competitive swimming club.
